WHO MUST FILE

- A separate report must be filed monthly (unless non-monthly reporting has been approved) by each designated operator of an offshore OCS, onshore, or Indian lease/agreement that contains active wells. Wells must be reported from the time active drilling is concluded and up until the status is changed to permanently abandoned or until all inventory is disposed.

WHEN TO FILE

- Reports must be received by the 15th of the second month following the production month (e.g., the report for June is due on August 15).
- You are required to report electronically under 30 CFR 1210 (2011) unless ONRR approved you to report on paper.
