### **States earn \$1.8 billion in FY 2010 Federal royalty receipts**

**DENVER** – The Department of the Interior’s Office of Natural Resources Revenue announced today that more than \$1.8 billion was disbursed to 34 states as part of the state share of Federal revenues collected in Fiscal Year 2010 from energy production that occurred on Federal onshore lands and offshore in the Outer Continental Shelf.
