I am the Executive Director of Youth Emergency Services, Inc. (Y.E.S. House) in Gillette Wyoming which is in the heart of Coal Country. The Y.E.S. House works with at risk youth who need prevention, intervention and treatment services.

Thank you for listening to our voices on "ending the war on coal" by lifting the leasing moratorium, ending the Programmatic Review of coal leasing that was intended to end mining on federal lands, and rescinding other rules designed to hurt coal mining.

**My Request is to rescind Office of Natural Resource Revenue's Consolidated Federal Oil and Gas and Federal and Indian Coal Valuation Reform (ONRR-2012-0004 (1012-AA13)) (the 2017 Valuation Rule).**

**Please rescind the 2017 Coal Valuation Rule that was designed to artificially drive up the cost of coal mining on federal land and damage coal exports and continue with the existing rules that work. The 2017 Valuation Rule creates undue complexity and confusion, is designed to inhibit coal mining on federal lands and, in doing so, would violate the Mineral Leasing Act.**
