PLAINTIFF IPAA'S MEMORANDUM IN OPPOSITION TO
THE DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

In its opening brief, the Independent Petroleum Association of America ("IPAA") showed that historically natural gas producers sold to pipelines at the lease and generally had no reason to move production downstream. When it was necessary to transport gas to market, however, producers deducted a government-approved rate or tariff from the value of production for royalty purposes. The deductible rate or tariff represented payment for a "bundle" of transportation-related
