ONRR Issues \$46,772 Civil Penalty to Jack J. Grynberg *Penalty cites company for failure to report production*

DENVER – The Department of the Interior’s Office of Natural Resources Revenue (ONRR) announced today that it assessed a \$46,772 civil penalty to Jack J. Grynberg (Grynberg) for failure to report production on Federal leases in Wyoming, Colorado and New Mexico.

ONRR issued a Notice of Noncompliance (NONC) to Grynberg on September 15, 2011, for failure to report production on the leases. “It is mandatory that companies report production on Federal leases, so we can ensure that proper royalties are paid on those taxpayer assets,” said ONRR Director Greg Gould.

The company failed to comply by the deadline established in the NONC, and has not yet fully complied. The penalty will continue to accrue until the necessary production reports are submitted.

Jack J. Grynberg has offices in Denver, Colorado.

The Office of Natural Resources Revenue, part of the Department’s Office of Policy, Management and Budget, is responsible for collecting and disbursing revenues from energy production that occurs onshore on Federal and American Indian lands, and offshore in the Outer Continental Shelf. During Fiscal Year 2013, the agency disbursed more than \$14.2 billion to states, American Indian Tribes and individual Indian mineral owners, and to various Federal accounts, including the U.S. Treasury, the Land and Water Conservation Fund, and the Reclamation Fund.

ONRR
