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States Earn More Than \$1.84 Billion in Federal Mineral Receipts

DENVER – The Department of the Interior’s Office of Natural Resources Revenue (ONRR) announced today that more than \$1.84 billion was disbursed to 37 states, counties and political subdivisions as part of the state share of Federal revenues collected in Fiscal Year 2015 from energy and mineral production that occurred on Federal lands within their borders and offshore on the Outer Continental Shelf.

Notes

1: Included in the state disbursements is \$2,441,209 disbursed to the Gulf coastal states of Alabama, Louisiana, Mississippi and Texas and their eligible coastal political subdivisions (counties and parishes) under provisions of the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006 (GOMESA).

2: Included in the state disbursements is \$3,764,650 disbursed to 36 counties in eight states from geothermal energy production.

3: Included in the state disbursements is \$158,653,871 returned to states for Mineral Leasing Act payments sequestered in FY 2014.

4: Excluded in the state disbursements is \$130,592,911.77 in FY 2015 payments sequestered in accordance with the Budget Control Act of 2011. In October 2015, ONRR returned to the states \$128,659,554.90 of the sequestered revenues.
