Mountain Hawk Energy, LLC Assessed Civil Penalty *Company Fails to Report Production*

DENVER – The Department of the Interior’s Office of Natural Resources Revenue (ONRR) announced today that it has issued a civil penalty of \$27,776 to Mountain Hawk Energy, LLC.

According to ONRR Director Greg Gould, the civil penalty follows an August 22, 2016 Notice of Noncompliance (NONC) that ONRR issued to the company. “Failure to submit production reports hampers ONRR’s ability to ensure that proper royalties are being paid,” Gould said.

The NONC was issued for failure to report production on Oil and Gas Operations Reports for numerous Federal properties. Mountain Hawk Energy failed to comply with this notice and file the appropriate reports in accordance with ONRR regulations.

Mountain Hawk Energy, LLC has offices in Athens, TX.

The Office of Natural Resources Revenue, part of the Department’s Office of Policy, Management and Budget, is responsible for the collection, disbursement and verification of revenues from energy production that occurs onshore on Federal and American Indian lands, and offshore on the Outer Continental Shelf. During Fiscal Year 2015, the agency disbursed more than \$9.8 billion to states, American Indian Tribes, individual Indian mineral owners, and to various Federal accounts, including the U.S. Treasury, the Land and Water Conservation Fund, and the Reclamation Fund.

ONRR
